Guidelines and Instructions to the Students and Parents

- Reporting Time:** The examination shall commence at 09:30 AM sharp. Students must report to the examination hall at least 15 minutes before the start time.
- Attendance Policy:** Attendance is compulsory. No re-examination shall be conducted for students who remain absent without valid and prior approval.
- Dress Code:** Students must attend the examination in proper school uniform. Entry will not be permitted otherwise.
- Stationery Requirements:** Students should bring all the necessary stationery items (pens, pencils, eraser, ruler, etc.). Borrowing or lending during the examination is strictly prohibited.
- Identity Verification:** Both admit cards and the School Identity cards must be carried on all examination days.
- Examination Conduct:** Students must maintain complete silence and discipline in the examination hall. Any unfair means or misconduct will result in strict disciplinary action.
- Electronic Devices:** Electronic gadgets such as smartwatches, mobile phones or calculators (unless specifically allowed) are not permitted inside the school premises. (Once confiscated, the gadgets will NOT be given back)
- Conveyance:** Students shall use only the regular and authorised transport facilities provided by the school or arranged by their parents. Students are strictly prohibited from using or riding motorcycles, scooters, or any other motorised two-wheelers for commuting to or from the school. In the event of any violation of this provision, the parent/guardian shall be solely responsible for complying with all applicable legal and statutory requirements, formalities, and consequences arising therefrom.
- Departure:** The students can leave the school immediately after the scheduled examination by the designated transport modes.
